IN THE WILD VBS

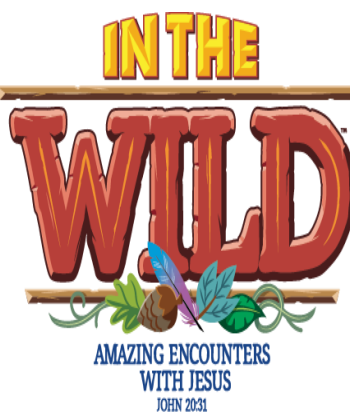
When: M-F June 17-21 6-8:30 pm
